Withdrawal of Request for Condition Authorizing Extended Ku-band
Receive for Antennas Currently Authorized by WB36 License

Dear Ms. Dortch,

Please accept this letter as a pleading to withdraw the request that was included in captioned Modification Application to add a condition to the WB36 license authorizing the Ku-band ESV antennas currently authorized by the license to receive Emissions using 10.7 – 10.95 GHz and 11.2 – 11.45 GHz frequencies.

As was explained in the Exhibit 10 which was submitted with the application as justification for the requested waiver the condition was requested in order to avoid, if possible, burdening the International Bureau staff with the work it would require to add eight new Emission Designators for each of the 29 Ku-band antennas. Marlink now understands, however that adding authorization to use the new frequency bands cannot be accomplished with a condition. Marlink is therefore withdrawing its request for same.

Marlink further understands that if it does want authorization for the currently license antennas to receive in the new frequency bands it will need to file an updated Schedule B. Marlink chooses not to do so at this time. Please complete processing of the Modification Application with no changes to the frequency bands for the current Emission Designators for the antennas now authorized by the WB36 license.
