Foreign Ownership of Applicant

Friendship Cable of Arkansas, Inc. (the "Applicant") is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Altice USA, Inc. ("Altice"). Through its parent companies, the Applicant is indirectly owned and controlled by Patrick Drahi, a citizen of Israel. On May 3, 2016, the Commission's Wireline Competition Bureau, International Bureau, Media Bureau, and Wireless Telecommunications Bureau approved the transaction proposed by Altice's parent companies – Altice N.V. and Cablevision Systems Corporation ("Cablevision") – under which Altice N.V., a publicly-traded company incorporated in the Netherlands and indirectly owned and controlled by Mr. Drahi, acquired 100 percent of the shares of Cablevision. In 2018, Altice filed applications for Commission consent to *pro forma* transfers of control as part of a corporate reorganization to remove several intermediate entities and separate Altice from Altice N.V. through a distribution of Altice's shares to Altice N.V. holders. Each of those transactions has been approved. As a result, the ultimate controlling party of Altice N.V. – Mr. Drahi – remains the ultimate controlling party of the Applicant.
