Dear Mr. Kelsay:

On April 15, 2005, Progressive Rural Telephone Cooperative, Inc., filed by paper a C-Band Receive-Only Earth Station Registration application. For reasons discussed below, we dismiss the application as defective, without prejudice to refiling.<sup>1</sup>

A review of the application has revealed the submitted Frequency Coordination and Interference Analysis Report is dated September 2004. Section 25.115(C)(iii)<sup>2</sup> of the Commission's rules requires re-coordination if the Schedule B is not filed within six months. In addition, as of November 5, 2004, all filings on Form 312 must be submitted electronically through IBFS.<sup>3</sup>

Accordingly, pursuant to Section 25.112(a)(1)<sup>4</sup> of the Commission's Rules, we dismiss your application, without prejudice.
