I worked on these two applications this morning. Unfortunately, I was only successful with one. I believe I'll need your help in order to rescue the other one.

First the good news:

- SES-REG-20180214-00114, E180017
 - To pay the fee, it was necessary to withdraw SES-AMD-INTR2018-00472 and start from scratch with a new amendment.
 - The new application was successfully filed as SES-AMD-INTR2018-00472 and I paid the fee.

Now the bad news:

- SES-REG-20180214-00122, E180021
 - I intended to withdraw the prior amendment (SES-AMD-INTR2018-00473) but somehow withdrew the original application by mistake.
 - See WTH2018022762629112, filed this morning at 6:26 AM. Truly, I'm not sure how I managed that blunder!
 - I have a draft amendment but the system won't let me file it because the underlying application has been withdrawn.
 - I understand I could start with a NEW application again but that would require paying yet another filing fee.
 - Is there any way to reinstate the underlying application (effectively reversing the withdrawal)?

Next I'll get started on the third amendment for WFOR-TV in Miami.
