Re: Correction To Earth Station License – E180671

This letter is in response to a October 12, 2020 email from Tyronda Brown concerning Fox Broadcasting Company's earth station license E180671. The Commission staff had noted that the license was for seven (7) antennas, yet Fox Corporation ("Fox," ultimate parent of Fox Broadcasting Company) had only requested lump sum election payment for two (2) antennas in its election of lump sum payment for 3.7-4.2 GHz band relocation expenses. See GN Docket No. 18-122 and IB Docket No. 20-205 (filed September 14, 2020).

Upon review of the license, we note that there was a clerical error with the underlying license application. There are only two (2) antennas at the registered site. Accordingly, the license should be adjusted to reflect the accurate count of antennas (all other technical specifications are correct). We note that the lump sum election contains the corrected number of antennas, thus, no further adjustments to Fox's lump sum calculation are required.
