On June 20<sup>th</sup> you filed the subject application for a Univision Network Limited Partnership C & Ku-Band Registration to operate with Permitted List satellites in the 3660 to 4220 MHz(C-band) and 11660-12220 (Ku-band) frequency bands.

We have a policy to not accept Ku-band receive only applications. Please call me so we can discuss a way forward on this application.

My proposal is that you allow me to:

- (1) strike all Ku-band frequencies and modify all C-band frequencies to 3700-4200 MHz and
- (2) change the satellite arc azimuth and elevation angles for 30 w - Azimuth angle: **109.92°** (True North) Elevation angle:**27.53°** and
- (3) change the satellite arc azimuth and elevation angles for 60w Azimuth angle: **139.77°** (True North) Elevation angle: **52.42°**

The Permitted Space Station List (Permitted List) is a list of all geostationary space stations providing fixed-satellite service pursuant to a Commission license or grant of U.S. market access. The Permitted List currently includes the following frequency bands per §25.103 and §25.115(k)(1): 3600-4200 MHz (space-to-Earth) 5850-6725 MHz (Earth-to-space) 10.95-11.2 GHz (space-to-Earth) 11.45-12.2 GHz (space-to-Earth) 13.75-14.5 GHz (Earth-to-space) 18.3-18.8 GHz (space-to-Earth) 19.7-20.2 GHz (space-to-Earth) 24.75-25.25 GHz (Earth-to-space) 28.35-28.6 GHz (Earth-to-space) 29.25-30.0 GHz (Earth-to-space). Earth stations with "Permitted List" designated as a point of communication may access any space station on the Permitted List, provided the operations comply with the applicable "routine" uplink and downlink limits, are within the specific frequency bands authorized in the earth station license, have completed coordination with terrestrial stations pursuant to §25.203, and otherwise comply with all terms and conditions of both the earth station license and the space station grant.
