Pittsford Educational Broadcasting Foundation (“PEBF”), licensee of receive-only earth station E190499 (“E190499”), hereby notifies the Commission that E190499 will not be transitioning to the upper 200 MHz of the 3.7-4.2 GHz band (C-Band). PEBF is no longer operating under E190499’s license, and has determined that it will discontinue operations under E190499’s license on a permanent basis. Accordingly, PEBF is also surrendering E190499’s authorization via the Commission’s myIBFS database simultaneously with this letter.
