This letter is filed through MyIBFS in response to an email received October 21, 2020, from IBFSINFO@fcc.gov requiring me to resolve a discrepancy between the earth stations in the August 3, 2020, List of Incumbent Earth Stations and the earth stations included in the Lump Sum Election filed for Stanford Communications Inc. ("Stanford") and its Earth Station E200500.

I have determined that Stanford's Application for Earth Station Authorization (FCC Form 312) filed October 17, 2018, erroneously indicated in response to Question E29 that there were 2 antennas associated with Antenna ID Westwood-1 (response to Question E28), and a "blank" was left in Question E29 with respect to Antenna ID Westwood-2.


This error resulted in "2" being displayed in the "Quantity" column in the August 3, 2020, List of Incumbent Earth Stations for both Antenna 1 and Antenna 2.

The information in the Application should be corrected to reflect the number "1" in Question E29 in the row for Antenna ID Westwood 1, and the number "1" in Question E29 in the row for Antenna ID Westwood 2. There are only two (2) antennas for which Stanford is making a lump-sum election as reflected in the Lump Sum Election filed on September 11, 2020.
