Dear Ms. Dortch:

On January 10, 2006, the Commission granted a renewal of license for the above-referenced earth station. Section H, Special and General Provision, of the renewed license grants the authorization, but references a condition to the effect that,

[u]pon completion of construction, each licensee must file with the Commission a certification including the following information: name of the licensee, file number of the applicant, call sign of the antenna, date of the license and certification that the facility as authorized has been completed, that each antenna facility has been tested and is within 2 dB of the pattern specified in Section 25.209 and that the station is operational including the date of commencement of service and will remain operational during the license period unless the license is submitted for cancellation.

This is to advise that the station in question has been in operation for many years and there is no “construction” to report in connection with the renewal of this license. (On January 24, my legal assistant spoke with Scott Kotler, Chief, Earth Station Division, who clarified that this provision was a “carry over” from the original application and should not be viewed as a condition to the renewal. Mr. Kotler further invited us to submit a letter so that the record is clear on this point.)

Signal Media of Arkansas, Inc. requests that this letter be made a part of the Commission’s file for this station.
