Re: Petition to reinstate E010082

Pursuant to §25.163 of the Rules and Regulations (“Regulations”) of the Federal Communications Commission (“Commission”), Harris CapRock Communications, Inc., (“Harris CapRock”) by way of the underlying application, petitions the Commission to reinstate call sign E010082 that expired May 18, 2011.

Pursuant to §25.163, “*a station authorization terminated...under the provisions of §25.161 may be reinstated if the Commission, in its discretion, determines that reinstatement would best serve the public interest, convenience and necessity. Petitions for reinstatement will be considered only if:*

- 1. The petition is filed within 30 days of the expiration date as set forth in §25.161(b);*
- 2. The petition explains the failure to file a timely notifications or renewal application; and*
- 3. The petition sets forth with specificity the procedures which have been established to insure timely filings in the future.”*

The instant petition is being filed within 8 days of the expiration date stated in the license (file number SES-LIC-20100314-00558). This license was assigned to Harris CapRock by Schlumberger Technology Corporation as a result of a recent partial asset purchase that closed last month. Consent to this assignment was granted by the FCC earlier this year, but license documentation has been in transition between the respective legal counsel of Schlumberger and Harris CapRock.¹ Consequently, there was an oversight as to the expiration date of this license.

Harris CapRock has added this call sign to its electronic license database to ensure that the license is flagged next time it comes up for renewal.

This license authorizes Harris CapRock to support critical infrastructure for hundreds of sites serving customers in the oil and gas industry. Granting of this reinstatement would serve the public interest, convenience and necessity by allowing these sites to continue to operate without interruption.
