

Explanatory Statement

On October 1, 2018, The Community Agency (“TCA”) filed an application to modify the registration for which renewal is sought (Call Sign E050128) to include additional antennas (File No. SES-MOD-20101001-03901). During the extended pendency of this modification application, caused by the high volume of C-band applications submitted in 2018, the registration expiration date passed on April 29, 2020. Nonetheless, the modification application was granted on July 14, 2020 (without change in the expiration date). Subsequently, the FCC declared the registration expired, removing it from the C-band Incumbent List issued on August 3, 2020 (after it had appeared on the initial July 6, 2020 version of that list).

In response to a Petition for Reconsideration filed on September 2, 2020, the International Bureau granted TCA’s request for relief and reinstated the registration. *See Incumbent Earth Stations in the 3.7-4.2 GHz Band in the Contiguous United States*, DA 20-1258 (IB, released Oct. 23, 2020), at 9 (¶¶ 23-24) (“*Omnibus C-Band Order*”). In doing so, the Bureau waived FCC Rules relating to the timing of submission of a renewal application and the automatic termination of authorizations when a timely renewal has not been filed. *Id.* at 9 (¶ 24) & n.59. As a result, the registration under Call Sign E050128 was restored to active status with a revised expiration date of November 6, 2020. Accordingly, this renewal application is timely and implements the relief granted in the *Omnibus C-band Order*.
