Renewal Application Narrative

Speedcast Communications Inc. (“Speedcast”), pursuant to Section 25.121(e) of the Federal Communications Commission (“Commission”) rules, 47 CFR § 25.121(e), hereby requests renewal of earth station license Call Sign E080102 (File No. SES-MFS-20081209-01559). Speedcast respectfully requests removal of two of the satellite points of communication specified in the license, SATMEX-5 and Eutelsat 113WA, which are no longer operating. All other technical and operational details will remain the same, including retained Permitted List authority, and Speedcast will continue to operate consistent with Commission rules and the terms and conditions of its license.

Renewal of the above referenced license is in the public interest because it will ensure continuity of service from the location. In addition, no harmful interference has been reported from the station and no potential interference concerns are raised by renewal of the license. Thus, Speedcast respectfully requests grant of this application at the earliest practicable time.

As set forth in Section 1.62(a)(1) of the Commission’s rules, should the renewal remain pending on the expiration date of the license, June 16, 2023, Speedcast understands that the filing of this renewal application will permit the license to “continue in effect” and thus provide authority for Speedcast to continue operating the earth station while the renewal is pending.¹

¹ See 47 C.F.R. § 1.62(a)(1) (providing that “[w]here there is pending before the Commission at the time of expiration of license any proper and timely application for renewal of license with respect to any activity of a continuing nature . . . , such license shall continue in effect without further action by the Commission until such time as the Commission shall make a final determination with respect to the renewal application”).
