NARRATIVE STATEMENT

Pursuant to Section 25.121(e) of the rules of the Federal Communications Commission (“Commission”),¹ Panasonic Avionics Corporation (“PAC”) hereby seeks timely renewal of its existing earth stations aboard aircraft (“ESAA”) blanket license, Call Sign E100089 (“ESAA Blanket License”). The ESAA Blanket License was initially granted for a term of fifteen years on September 7, 2011 with an effective date of August 31, 2011,² and most recently modified to include additional satellite points of connections for its existing earth station terminals with approval granted on December 31, 2025.³ The current term expires on August 31, 2026.

This renewal application does not seek to modify the ESAA Blanket License or make any changes to PAC’s currently authorized operating parameters, nor does the application seek renewal of operations in a frequency band subject to a freeze or restriction on new or renewed licenses.⁴ Renewal will serve the public interest by enabling PAC to continue delivering reliable, high-speed, satellite-enabled in-flight entertainment and connectivity services to its customers in the United States and throughout the world.

Accordingly, PAC respectfully requests that the Commission grant this request to renew its ESAA Blanket License, Call Sign E100089.
