Dear **Mr. Abelso**n:

This is in response to the Commission's request for approval of an extension to a Special Temporary Authority (STA) granted to VISTAR to operate up to 10,000 half-duplex Mobile Earth Terminals (METs) by waiver in the maritime portion of the 1.5/1.6 GHz MSS bands. The request is in two parts, a 6 month extension of the STA and an increase in the number of METs to 20;000. We note that the Commission is expected to release shortly an order that will provide new additional rules for the operation of MSS half-duplex terminals that will likely have some bearing on VISTAR's future operations of METs.

**NTIA** previously agreed to a total of 30,000 half-duplex **METs** to be operated by waiver in the maritime portion of the 1.5/1.6 **GHz** MSS bands. Given the number of **METs** currently authorized, I understand that there is room for VISTAR to be authorized additional **METs** without exceeding this 30,000 total. We therefore do not object to extending the STA for an additional 6 month time period nor to authorizing VISTAR to operate additional half-duplex **METs** not to exceed the 30,000 total.
