The purpose of this letter is to confirm our telephone conversation today regarding the above referenced request for special temporary authority ('STA"), which the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") issued to our client, PetroCom, on September 13, 2005.

As I explained in my letter to you of that date, PetroCom required STA to replace landline facilities provided by BellSouth that were damaged by Hurricane Katrina. The BellSouth facilities specified in PetroCom's STA request have been restored. Consequently, PetroCom no longer requires authority for the earth station covered by the STA. PetroCom will not, therefore, seek renewal of the STA or provide the FCC with the frequency coordination and interference report specified in paragraph 4 of the STA grant.
