Telenor Satellite, Inc. hereby withdraws the above-referenced applications, which seek special temporary authority for Telenor's Southbury, CT earth stations WA28 and KA312 to access the Inmarsat 4F2 satellite at 52.75° W.L. Although Telenor still seeks to modify its licenses for those two earth stations to allow communications with Inmarsat 4F2, neither earth station is communicating with that satellite at this time, and neither has done so since the satellite was launched. Accordingly, the authorizations sought in these applications are no longer required.
