Universal Space Network, Inc.'s application for Special Temporary Authority is GRANTED WITH CONDITIONS beginning August 1, 2006 and ending August 30, 2006.

1. All operations shall be on an unprotected, non-interference basis. In addition, USN uplink/downlink frequency (2090.292/2270.00) overlaps with NASA's Cluster-3 (2090.292/2270.00) and MAP (2090.6/2270.4), and HotBird-8 will have mutual visibility to Hawaii and Goldstone. Both Cluster-3 and MAP will be tracked by Goldstone during the month of August.
2. All operations shall expire no later than 10-days from the date of launch.
3. All operations shall be limited to launch and early orbit.
4. Universal Space Network will inform NTIA (edavison@ntia.doc.gov, 202-482-5526) and the FCC (Scott.Kotler@fcc.gov, 202-418-0596) at least 24 hours prior to the planned launch and commencement of operations if the launch is delayed beyond August 4, 2006.
