On November 14, 2006, the International Bureau granted the above-referenced requests for special temporary authorization ("STA") to use two earth stations licensed to WB Holdings 1, LLC for in-orbit testing of the WildBlue-1 satellite at the 109.2° W.L. orbital location. Pursuant to those authorizations, this is to notify the Commission that the satellite was successfully launched on December 8, 2006. Accordingly, these STAs commenced on December 18, 2006 and will expire on February 16, 2007. The satellite arrived at its IOT location on December 20, 2006.

WB Holdings will provide information on its plan for IOT and a 24/7 point of contact for IOT operations under separate cover, as it has already done for NTIA.
