

This letter is filed pursuant to Section 1.65 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations to update the public interest showing made in support of the above-reference request for special temporary authority (STA).

The earth station that is the subject of the STA request is used to distribute a video programming service operated by the licensee known as "Sorpresal", the nation's only full-time Spanish language children's television channel, which includes a substantial amount of programming that qualifies as "educational/informational" under Media Bureau standards for television broadcasters and broadcast satellite systems. This service is currently carried by cable television systems and also provides content for Verizon Wireless' V-Cast mobile service. The new capital that will be infused as a result of the proposed merger will allow an immediate expansion of the service by allowing for the hiring of both marketing and programming personnel that are needed for what the licensee hopes will be a launch in the very near future with DirectTV and Dish Network. These satellite services will bring the licensee's Hispanic children's programs to rural areas, including Native American tribal reservations, which do not now have access because they do not have cable television service. The satellite operators will expect the licensee to actively market the launch and to expand program offerings, both of which require funds to be provided by the merger, and both of which the licensee is ready to implement immediately when the funds are available.

Juniper Partners Acquisition Corp. acknowledges that the special temporary authority it has requested, if granted, may be revoked by the Commission without a hearing.
