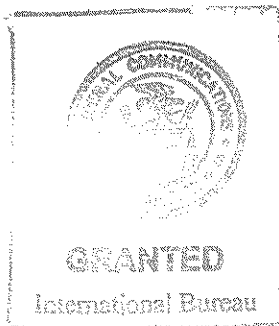

REQUEST FOR SPECIAL TEMPORARY AUTHORITY

Vizada Satellite, Inc. ("VSI"), formerly Telenor Satellite, Inc., hereby requests renewal of special special temporary authority "STA") to communicate with up to 300 C-band earth stations on vessels (ESVs") via its Santa Paula, CA Teleport while the Bureau considers its pending application for permanent ESV authorization, File No. SES-MOD-20070523-00709, filed May 23, 2007. All operations will be consistent with that application.

The hub antenna to be used for ESV operation is a 13 meter Universal, which is currently approved for operation under call sign KA249. See File No. SES-MOD-20061207-02107, granted Jan. 16, 2007. The hub antenna will communicate with the NSS-5 satellite.

The ESV antennas to be used are the SeaTel 9797 and the SeaTel 9707. As demonstrated in VSI's underlying application, these antennas will meet the off-axis EIRP spectral density envelope set forth in 47 CFR § 25.221(a)(1)-(4) when the input power to the antenna system is limited to -7dBW/4kHz. Accordingly, these antennas can be operated in accordance with the Commission's ESV rules, as well as its 2° spacing policy.

Moreover, as demonstrated in VSI's underlying application, VSI has engaged Comsearch and Skjei Telecom to conduct an interference study and frequency coordination which has successfully identified a continuous route along the entire U.S. Pacific coast (including Alaska) and into the five largest U.S. Pacific coast ports that ships using C-band ESV equipment on VSI frequencies may follow without causing objectionable interference to fixed service operations. Other ports will be coordinated on an as-needed basis. ESV's receiving C-band service via the Santa Paula teleport and located within 200km of the United States will only operate in the areas that have been successfully coordinated.

The Bureau previously granted an STA for C-band ESV operation to Telenor Satellite, Inc. File No. SES-STA-20070524-00718, granted July 16, 2007. VSI seeks renewal of that STA in order to continue providing needed ESV services to its customers.

VSI seeks special temporary authority for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days. Accordingly, public notice of this application is not required.

EXPLANATION OF NAME CHANGE

On September 6, 2007, counsel for Inceptum 1 AS informed the Commission that pursuant to the authority granted by the Commission (*Authorizations Granted, Telenor ASA, Transfer, and Inceptum 1, AS, Transfer, Seek FCC Consent to Transfer Control of Licenses and Authorizations and a Declaratory Ruling on Foreign Ownership*, IB Docket No. 06-225, DA 07-2163 (IB, WTB & OET, rel. May 23, 2007)), the transfer of control of Telenor Satellite Services AS and its FCC-licensed subsidiaries (including Telenor Satellite, Inc.) to Inceptum was consummated on September 5, 2007. Following this consummation, the name of Telenor Satellite, Inc. was legally changed to Vizada Satellite, Inc. This is only a name change; there has been no change in the ownership or corporate structure of Vizada Satellite, Inc. beyond that authorized by the Commission in its May 2007 order.
