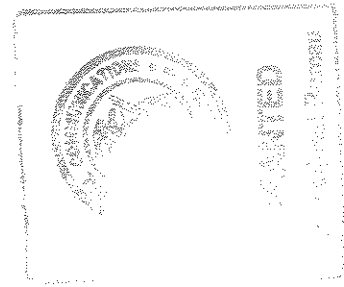

**EXHIBIT A**

This Request for Special Temporary Authorization (“STA”) seeks FCC consent for continuing authority for The North American Mission Board of the Southern Baptist Convention, Inc. (“NAMB”) to utilize an earth station (former call sign E6420) (the “Station”), Benbrook, Texas, pending the consideration and grant by the FCC of NAMB’s application for a new license. NAMB filed the application with the FCC on September 17, 2007. (Submission ID IB2007002247.)

The FCC license for the Station expired on July 5, 2006 without NAMB having filed a timely application for renewal of the Station’s license. On July 16, 2007, NAMB reported this circumstance to the FCC and filed a Request for STA seeking ongoing authority to operate the Station pending the filing by NAMB and grant by the FCC of an application for a new license. As explained in the original Request for STA, the failure to file a renewal application was an inadvertent error as the result of an oversight. On July 20, 2007, the FCC granted NAMB an STA to continue operating the Station until September 20, 2007. *See* SES-STA-20070716-00955.

Upon completion of the technical and other application requirements, NAMB filed, on September 17, 2007, a Form 312 application with the FCC for full authority to operate the Station. NAMB respectfully requests the FCC’s permission to continue to operate the Station until the application is processed and granted.
