

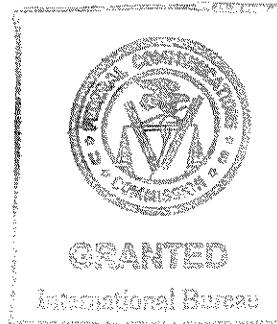

The STA will specifically support a Fixed Earth Station that will be communicating with a satellite via a teleport.
