Attachment 1: STA Request Explanation

Hawaii Pacific Teleport, L.P. was recently awarded a contract to provide service under an Australian Government-funded program to provide mission critical satellite communications to 12 island states in the South West and South East Pacific.

This Australian government communications contract is part of the government's anti-terror initiative in the Pacific region, to enable more timely information between the islands and Australia via an Australia-to-Hawaii fiber link and satellite from Hawaii to the islands on the GE-23 ku-band satellite.

Hawaii Pacific Teleport, L.P. is required to start providing ku-band satellite service on the GE-23 satellite (172E) on January 15, 2008 using the 4.5m ku-band antenna at the teleport. As such, it respectfully requests special temporary authority to enable the licensee to commence ku-band transmissions on that date.
