TeleAlaska hereby requests a Special Temporary Authority (STA) to allow for operation of a Prodelin 3.8 Meter C-band earth station antenna at the St Paul site in Alaska. This STA request is necessary to permit TeleAlaska to provide communication services to the population at the remote site in St Paul, AK. This earth station will be the only means of communication at this site. Due to the remote location of this site, services would not be otherwise available. The earth station will provide access to emergency services and provide other communication needs. This STA is requested for a period of 30 days beginning 8/8/2008.

This STA is submitted in conjunction with a permanent license.
