REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF SPECIAL TEMPORARY AUTHORITY

PEARL CITY, HI – E860046

AT&T Corp. ("AT&T") respectfully requests that an extension to Special Temporary Authority ("STA") SES-STA-20080804-01024 be granted in order to provide for continued operation of existing earth station E860046, Pearl City, HI, as described in attached EXHIBIT 2. The STA is requested for a two month period beginning October 6, 2008, through December 6, 2008, pending the approval of a license modification currently on file with the Commission. A Frequency Coordination and a Radiation Hazard Study is attached to the license modification application, assigned file number SES-MOD-INTR2008-02387. Operating particulars remain the same as with the original STA request.

This STA is requested to provide continued voice and data services to the United States Navy by changing the satellite arc and satellite to which E860046 communicates. Services were moved from a satellite that is was deactivated on August 7, 2008.

AT&T understands that the testing and operation of the earth station shall comply with Federal Communications Commission Rules and Regulations, and that the authorization by the Federal Communications Commission is subject to change in any of its terms or to cancellation in its entirety at any time upon reasonable notice but without hearing, if in the opinion of the Commission, circumstances should so require.

AT&T further understands that all operations must be conducted on a non-interference basis, and in the unlikely event that harmful interference occurs, transmissions will cease immediately; and the grant of this temporary authorization is not to be construed in any way as an approval for the regular use of this earth station facility or satellite communications.
