By this letter, Vizada wishes to amend the point of communication from the Inmarsat 4F3 satellite located at 97.65° W.L. to the Inmarsat 3F4 satellite located at 54° W.L.

On January 7, 2009, Inmarsat Existing and Evolved (E&E) services will transition from the Inmarsat 4F2 satellite at 52.75° W.L. to the Inmarsat 3F4 satellite, and thus Vizada respectfully requests authority for up to 1,000 Inmarsat C mobile earth terminals to communicate with the Inmarsat 3F4 satellite.
