

Following up on our telephone conversation yesterday, I am transmitting herewith on behalf of Row 44, Inc. ("Row 44") individual statements signed on behalf of each of the three satellite operators that are parties to the February 6, 2009 letter agreement concerning test flight operations of the Row 44 AMSS system. *See Row 44, Inc.*, STA Order and Authorization, DA 09-585, slip op. at 2 (¶ 4) & n.4 (Sat.
