REQUEST FOR SPECIAL TEMPORARY AUTHORITY

Bank of America has contracted with GNSC to monitor the earth station. GNSC is a responsible satellite operator and licensee in its own right and makes every effort to follow all Commission requirements -- as evidenced by its general review that brought the expiration of the E9990192 authorization to light. GNSC is experienced with earth station licensing procedures and has integrated this license into its "toggler" system to ensure that future renewal and other deadlines are noted and met.

In conclusion, Bank of America utilizes this earth station in providing its public broadcasting service. Its failure to file the E990192 renewal application in a timely manner was inadvertent. Bank of America has retained GNSC which has a well established and successful toggler system to ensure future compliance with deadlines. Also, the use of E990192 is integral to the public interest in providing financial information and assistance to the public. Accordingly, it is in the public interest to grant the renewal of the E990192 authorization.
