Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's Rules (47 C.F.R. § 1.1206(b)), notice is hereby provided in the above-referenced application dockets regarding an oral *ex parte* presentation by telephone on January 25, 2011 by counsel to Panasonic Avionics Corporation ("Panasonic") to staff of the International Bureau ("Bureau"). Participating on behalf of Panasonic was Carlos M. Nalda of Squire, Sanders & Dempsey (US) LLP. Participating on behalf of the Bureau were Stephen Duall, Paul Blais and William Bell. The proceedings have been designated as "permit but disclose" by the Bureau.<sup>1</sup>

The purpose of the teleconference was to discuss the procedural posture and factual background of Panasonic's pending AMSS license application and STA request. In particular, the participants discussed (i) the extent of requested authority under the license application and STA request (number of terminals, frequencies, satellite points of communication, etc.); (ii) the status of coordination discussions with respect to U.S. government operations (radio astronomy and NASA TDRRS facilities); (iii) the status of Panasonic's existing experimental authority (procedural background, number of terminals, frequencies, satellite points of communication, etc.); and (iv) Panasonic's prior consultations with Commission staff responsible for experimental licensing regarding the extent of its limited market study authority.


