## 12. Description

GUSA Licensee LLC is seeking special temporary authority to operate the TCU earth station antenna at Clifton, TX to support the launch campaign of Globalstar's second-generation constellation, and in particular, to communicate with its satellites launched on July 13, 2011 (from Baikonur, Kazakhstan). This request for STA concerns communication with Globalstar's French-licensed second-generation constellation, though the antenna will be used to communicate with satellites in Globalstar's first-generation constellation (FCC call sign S2115). Globalstar has filed five separate applications for extension of special temporary authority -- one for each antenna at the Clifton, TX location, and Globalstar requests that they be processed simultaneously. Multiple earth station antennas provide opportunities for telemetry and control of multiple satellites in view simultaneously at a ground location, which is a common occurrence for a LEO satellite constellation.
