Re: Request for Special Temporary Authority

Dear Ms. Dortch:


Macy's Inc. ("Macy's"), proposed operator of a new satellite-uplink system to be installed in Johns Creek, Georgia, hereby requests a Special Temporary Authority to operate a new 3.7-meter Ku-band antenna to be installed as the hub of its satellite training and operations network. This network will be used to deliver audio, video, and data as a part of a satellite-delivered new employee training program.

Concurrently with this request for a Special Temporary Authority, Macy's has submitted an application for authorization to operate the 3.7-meter Ku-band antenna at its facilities in Johns Creek, Georgia. The File Number for this application is SES-LIC-20110913-01074 with a Call Sign of E110128.

Without the Special Temporary Authority requested herein, Macy's would have insufficient time to install, test, implement and make operational its new satellite distance training and operations network by the commencement of the upcoming holiday season. This employee training program will be a very important instrument in the hiring, and subsequent training, of new employees for the holiday season and beyond.

Accordingly, Macy's respectfully requests Special Temporary Authority to install and operate a new 3.7-meter Ku-band antenna for a period of six (6) months, or until permanent authority to do so has been granted by the Commission.
