[CoverEdge] is granted, under the following conditions, Special Temporary Authority for 3 days, from 04/10/2012 through 05/09/2012, to operate a transmit only, temporary fixed earth station with ALSAT over a 2.4 m Andrew Corporation antenna, model ESA24VSM-KU within the conventional Ku-band ¹with emission no greater than 36M0F3F and maximum Equivalent Isotropically Radiated Power (EIRP) of 36.8 dBW/4kHz based on the following conditions:

1. Operations under this authority are on a non-interference basis only.

- 2. In the event that there is a report of interference, CoverEdge must immediately terminate transmissions and notify the FCC in writing.
- 3. This request is granted without prejudice to any future FCC enforcement action in connection with any unauthorized operation of radio facilities.
- 4. All operations shall be on a non-common carrier basis.
- 5. The licensee shall take extraordinary measures to ensure that the antenna does not create the potential for exposure of persons who may be within the immediate vicinity to radiofrequency radiation in excess of FCC safety guideline to prevent human exposure in excess of the FCC-specified safety limit of 1 mW/cm2. Warning signs, such as those discussed in the FCC's OET Bulletin 65, shall be posted informing members of the public to keep outside the exposure area that exceeds limit.
- 6. Transmitter(s) must be turned off during antenna maintenance to ensure compliance with the FCC-specified safety guidelines for human exposure to radiofrequency radiation in the region between the antenna feed and the reflector. Appropriate measures must also be taken to restrict access to other regions in which the earth station's power flux density levels exceed the specified guidelines.
