Science Applications International Corporation is granted Special Temporary Authority (STA) for a 30-day period, from September 8, 2012 through October 7, 2012 to use its earth station in the Guam –Naval Station, GU area (13° 25' 57.0" N.L/ 144° 39' 36.0" E.L.) to conduct U.S. Pacific Command (PACOM) exercise within the transmit frequency range 5925-6425 MHz and to receive within 3700-4200 MHz to Intelsat IS-19 satellite at orbital location 166.0 ° E.L.

All operations shall be on an unprotected and non-harmful interference basis, Science Applications International Corporation, shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from, interference caused to it by any other lawfully operating station and it shall cease transmission(s) immediately upon notice of such interference.
