Dear Mr. Blais,

We have on file an outstanding request for Special Temporary Authority (STA) referenced above. By this letter SURE SHOT TRANSMISSIONS Inc. modifies the STA as follows: Operation of call sign E940617 will only be in the 14.0-14.5 GHz (Earth-to-space) and 11.7-12.2 GHz (space-to-Earth) frequency bands. Operations will only be with the consent of target satellite operators. Emissions will be limited to no greater than a maximum eirp per carrier of 78 dBW, with a maximum eirp density of 46.01 dBW for emission designator of 36M0F9W. My request is that the FCC grant SES-STA-20120920-00841, with a begin date of 1/20/2013 and ending date of 03/20/2013, (60 days) within the limitations above and only with US satellites.

SURE SHOT TRANSMISSIONS, INC. has amended the pending modification, SES-MOD-20120912-00810, on 01/04/2013, SES-AMD-20130104-0004 to specify and clarify all antenna transmit and receive frequency gains, emission designators and effective isotropic radiated power (eirp) and density values, all transmit and receive frequency coordination values and all satellite points of communications.

It is with my understanding that this Amendment and application is under review at this time and may take up to 30 days after public notice if granted. SURE SHOT TRANSMISSIONS INC, requests your consideration in this matter so that we may continue to conduct business while going through this process.
