Rogers Communication is granted special temporary authority from April 23, 2013 to April 24, 2013, to operate a temporary-fixed earth station in the Plymouth, MI vicinity to communicate with GALAXY 3C, Call Sign S2381, at the 95.05° W. L. orbital location, in the 14.0-14.50 GHz, Earth-to-space frequency band under the following conditions:

1. Rogers Communication shall operate with an antenna size of at least 1.2 meters, with an antenna gain of no more than 40 dBi, and EIRP density not to exceed -14dBw/4kHz.
2. Rogers Communication shall limit communications to digital emissions.
3. Rogers Communications, shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from, interference caused to it by any other lawfully operating station and it shall cease transmission(s) immediately upon notice of such interference.
4. In the event that there is a report of interference Rogers Communications must immediately terminate transmissions and notify the FCC in writing.
5. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this special temporary authority is solely at Rogers Communications.

This action is issued pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. § 0.261, and is effective immediately.
