Special Temporary Authority

SES Americom Inc. (SES) is granted, under the following conditions, special temporary authority for 30 days to operate the NWM-16 and NWM-17 antennas to receive 4500-4800 MHz frequencies from the Netherlands-licensed SES-6 satellite at its Bristow, Virginia teleport to perform non-protected basis, non-interfering service for the limited temporary purpose of monitoring customer carriers to ensure quality of service. The customer carriers that will be monitored under the requested authority are all intended to be received outside of the United States.

1. All operations shall be on an unprotected and non-harmful interference basis, SES , E000696, shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from, interference caused to it by any other lawfully operating station and it shall cease transmission(s) immediately upon notice of such interference.
2. SES must notify the Mid-Atlantic Frequency Coordinator (MIDAF) coordination and notification of NAVY POC, Mr. Robert Goddard at 301-342-1194 (robert.n.goddard@navy.mil) prior to operations.
3. In the event that there is a report of interference, SES, E000696, must immediately terminate transmissions and notify the FCC in writing.
4. Grant of this authorization shall not prejudice the outcome of any future rulemaking, pending or future application.
5. Grant of this authorization does not constitute a grant of access to the market in the United States under the Commission's DISCO II policies.
6. Per US 245 the use of the non-Federal fixed-satellite service is limited to international inter-continental systems.

APPLICATION FOR SPECIAL TEMPORARY AUTHORITY
(Call Sign E000696, NWM-16 and NWM-17)

SES Americom, Inc. (“SES”) respectfully requests a 30-day Special Temporary Authority (“STA”) to receive signals in the 4500-4800 MHz from the Netherlands-licensed SES-6 satellite at 40.5° W.L. using antennas NWM-16 and NWM-17 on earth station E000696. *See SES Americom, Inc.*, File No. SES-MFS-20130604-00470 (granted in part Mar. 14, 2014). The proposed receipt of such signals will be on a temporary, non-protected basis for the limited purpose of monitoring customer carriers to ensure quality of service. The customer carriers that will be monitored under the requested authority are all intended to be received outside of the United States.

Grant of the requested temporary authority will serve the public interest by enabling SES to monitor and manage the quality of service provided to customers outside the United States in the 4500-4800 MHz band from SES’s Network Operations Center (“NOC”) in Bristow, Virginia. As is typical, grant of the requested STA will be on a non-protected, non-harmful interference basis. SES respectfully requests **expedited action by no later than May 19, 2014**, so that carrier monitoring at SES’s Virginia NOC can support preparations for telecasts of the World Cup in Brazil.

SES acknowledges that grant of the requested authority would not prejudge the Commission’s consideration of SES’ pending request for long-term authority to receive in the 4500-4800 MHz band using the NWM-16 and NWM-17 antennas. *See SES Americom, Inc.*, File No. SES-MFS-20130604-00470 (deferred in part Mar. 14, 2014).
