Request for Extension of Special Temporary Authority

On September 11, 2014, O3b Limited ("O3b") filed a request for special temporary authority ("STA") to conduct tests at the O3b facility in Bristow, Virginia, using two 1.2m antennas, during the 30-day period between October 20, 2014 and November 19, 2014.¹ O3b, pursuant to Section 25.120 of the Commission's rules,² hereby requests an extension of its STA covering the 30-day period between November 20, 2014, and December 20, 2014.
