Special Temporary Authority (STA)

EchoStar Broadcasting Corporation (EBC) is granted STA, beginning August 15, 2015, for 60 days, to operate its fixed earth station, 3.7 meter antenna, in Cheyenne, WY with the following satellites: ECHOSTAR 1 @77 W.L., ECHOSTAR 8 @ 76.85 W.L., Echostar and Dish satellites at 61.5, 110, and 119 WL clusters, CIEL 2 satellite @ 128.85 W.L., NIMIQ 5 @72.7 W.L., ECHOSTAR 15 @ 45.1 W.L., and ECHOSTAR 6 (S2232) @ 96.2 W.L. in the 17300 –17310 MHz, 17300 – 17800 MHz, and 17790 – 17800 MHz (Earth-to-space) and 12200 -12210 MHz, and 12690 – 12700 MHz (space-to-Earth) frequency bands under the following conditions:

1. Operations must comply with the technical parameters specified in its underlying application, IBFS File no. SES-AMD-20150114-00009.
2. Grant of this STA is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding pending or future EchoStar Broadcasting Corporation applications.
3. All operations under this grant of STA shall be on an unprotected and non-harmful interference basis. EchoStar Broadcasting Corporation E010242 shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from interference caused to it by, any other lawfully operating radio communication system.
4. In the event of any harmful interference as a result of operations under this grant of STA, EchoStar Broadcasting Corporation shall cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference and shall immediately inform the Commission, in writing, of such an event.
5. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this STA is solely at EchoStar Broadcasting Corporation's risk.

Request for Renewal of Sixty (60) Day Special Temporary Authority

Pursuant to Section 25.120(b)(3) of the Federal Communications Commission's ("FCC") rules,¹ EchoStar Broadcasting Corporation ("EBC") requests that the FCC renew special temporary authority ("STA") for another sixty (60) days to operate a 3.7m earth station antenna in Cheyenne, Wyoming. Grant of the STA is in the public interest as it will enable EBC to improve its satellite fleet management by providing additional resiliency of operations. By enabling such resiliency, EBC will be in a better position to manage and maintain its satellite fleet in the event such backup is needed.

EBC has a pending application for regular authority for this 3.7m antenna.² On May 13, 2015, the FCC granted a 60 day STA to operate the 3.7m from June 15, 2015 to August 14, 2015 while the application for regular authority was pending.³ At this time, the application for regular authority remains pending. Accordingly, EBC requests that the FCC renew the STA so that EBC has authorization to continue to operate.

¹ Under Section 25.120(b)(3), the FCC may grant this STA for 60 days without putting the application on public notice because EBC has filed an application for regular authority for the 3.7m antenna, which is still pending. *See* 47 C.F.R. § 25.120(b)(3).
