STA grant conditions:

DG Consents Sub, Inc. is granted special temporary authority, extension with conditions, for a period of 60 days, from August 9, 2015 to October 7, 2015, to operate its Rock Springs, WY, fixed earth station (call sign E120040) to receive Earth imaging data using the uppermost 25 MHz of the 8025 MHz band ("X-band").

- 1) Operations under this STA shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from, interference caused to it by any other lawfully operating station and it shall cease transmission(s) immediately upon notice of such interference.
- 2) Grant of this STA is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding other pending applications or future STA requests.
- 3) Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this STA is solely at the applicant's risk.
- 4) This action is issued pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. §0.261, and is effective immediately.

Description

DG Consents Sub, Inc. (“DG Consents”), pursuant to Section 25.120(b)(3) of the Commission’s rules, 47 C.F.R. § 25.120(b)(3), hereby requests a 60-day extension of its existing Special Temporary Authority (“STA”) to receive Earth imaging data using the uppermost 25 MHz of the 8025-8400 MHz band (the “X-band”).¹ *See* File No. SES-STA-20150224-00100, as extended by File No. SES-STA-20150602-00318. The existing STA expires on August 8, 2015, and DG Consents requests an extension through October 7, 2015.

The requirement to use the 8375-8400 MHz band will continue past the August 8 expiration of the existing STA, thereby necessitating this request to extend the STA for an additional 60 days.² DigitalGlobe agrees to operate on a special temporary basis subject to the conditions included with the initial STA grant. Grant of this request will serve the public interest by allowing DigitalGlobe to continue to provide to the public without interruption its high-resolution imagery services using the Wyoming earth station.

In summary, DG Consents respectfully requests that the Commission grant this request for extension of its Special Temporary Authority for a period of 60 days through October 7, 2015.

¹ DG Consents is a wholly owned subsidiary of DigitalGlobe, Inc. (“DigitalGlobe”).

² DG Consents has filed a request seeking permanent use of the full 8025-8400 MHz band. *See* File No. SES-MOD-20140717-00604, as amended by File No. SES-AMD-20140725-00620. That request was accepted for filing on August 6, 2014, *see* Public Notice, Report No. SES-01670, and remains pending before the Commission.
