Dear Ms. Dortch,

This letter serves as a response to FCC inquiry on 30 September, 2015 regarding the above mentioned Application for Special Temporary Authority ("**STA**") filed by Inmarsat on 23 September, 2015. The two inquiries are numbered below with answers following.

1. <u>Which antennas will be at each site?</u> Are all three antenna types at each location or only <u>one at each location?</u>

Inmarsat anticipates using and testing each of the three different antenna types at each different location.

2. <u>Please provide the manufacturer, antenna model and certification that each antenna</u> <u>complies 47 U.S.C. §25.209 gain patterns or 47 U.S.C. §25.138 EIRP patterns.</u>

<u>Manufacturer</u>: Skyware <u>Model</u>: Sky98 (98cm)

Manufacturer: L3 <u>Models</u>: Panther (60cm) Cheetah (85cm)

Inmarsat confirms that the terminals will comply with §25.138 of the Commission's rules.
