Special Temporary Authority (STA)

EchoStar Broadcasting Corporation is granted Special Temporary Authority (STA) for 180 days beginning December 14, 2015, to use its Gilbert, AZ. Ku-band earth station, Call sign E080007, to maintain the EchoStar 15 (S2811) as an in-orbit spare (IOT) at 61.65°W.L orbital location using the 17,791.5 MHz and 17,793.5 MHz (Earth-to-space), and 12,692.0 MHz, 12,693.0 MHz, 12,694.5 MHz, and 12,698.5 MHz (space-to-Earth) center frequencies to conduct telemetry, tracking, and command (TT&C) necessary to maintain EchoStar 15 at the 61.65° W.L. orbital location under the following conditions:

1. All operations under this grant of STA shall be on an unprotected and non-harmful interference basis. EchoStar shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from interference caused to it by, any other lawfully operating radio communication system.
2. In the event EchoStar's operations under this grant of special temporary authority cause harmful interference to any other lawfully operating radio communication system, EchoStar must cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference and shall immediately inform the Commission, in writing, of such an event.
3. EchoStar must operate only the (TT&C) frequencies on EchoStar 15 to maintain EchoStar 15 at the 61.65° W.L. orbital location.
4. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this STA is solely at EchoStar Broadcasting Corporation LLC's risk.

This grant is issued pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. § 0.261, and is effective upon release.
