Special Temporary Authority (STA)

Intelsat License LLC is granted a STA, under the following conditions, for 30 days, beginning December 20, 2015, to use its Hagerstown, Maryland Ku-band earth station, call-sign: KA258, to provide launch and early orbit phase ("LEOP") services for the Express AMU1 satellite at permanent orbital location 36° E.L., licensed by Russian Federation. The in-orbit testing location will be 69.5 ° E.L. The launch is expected to be on December 20, 2015.

1. Uplink (Earth-to-space) frequencies will be on 17301.50 MHz and 17303.00 MHz (RCHP or LCHP) within the coordinated emission and power limits.
2. Downlink (space-to-Earth) frequencies will be on 11700.20 MHz and 11702.50 MHz (RCHP or LCHP).
3. Operations under this STA authorization is only for its Hagerstown, Maryland teleport to provide launch and early orbit phase (LEOP) services for the Express AMU1 satellite.
4. All operators of satellites will be provided with an emergency phone number where the licensee can be reached in the event that harmful interference occurs, Currently the 24x7 contact information for the Express AMU1 mission is as follows: Ph.: (703) 559-7701 - East Coast Operations Center (primary); (310) 525-5591 - West Coast Operations Center (back-up). Request to speak with Harry Burnham or Kevin Bell.
5. All operations under this grant of STA shall be on an unprotected and non-harmful interference basis. Intelsat License LLC's shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from interference caused to it by, any other lawfully operating radio communication system.
6. In the event of any harmful interference under this grant of STA, Intelsat License LLC, must cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference, and must inform the Commission, in writing, immediately of such an event.
7. Grant of this authorization is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding pending or future Intelsat License LLC applications.
8. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this STA is solely 'at Intelsat License LLC's risk.
9. This action is issued pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. §0.261, and is effective immediately.
