Hawaii Pacific Teleport, L.P. ("Hawaii Pacific") is granted a special temporary authority, extension from SES-STA-20160323-00268, for 30 days, beginning May 10, 2016, to operate a 1.2 meter antenna located at its Kapolei (Honolulu), HI teleport to provide in-orbit testing ("IOT") of the Nimiq-2 at 148° E.L. orbital location in the 29.50-30 GHz (Earth-to-space) frequency band under the following conditions.

1. All operations under this grant of STA shall be on an unprotected and non-harmful interference basis. Intelsat's shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from interference caused to it by, any other lawfully operating radio communication system.
2. In the event of any harmful interference under this grant of STA, Hawaii Pacific must cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference, and must inform the Commission, in writing, immediately of such an event.
3. Grant of this authorization is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding pending or future Hawaii Pacific's applications.
4. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this STA is solely at Hawaii Pacific's risk.
5. Operations during the period May 7, 2016 to the date of this grant were authorized pursuant to Section 1.62 of the Commission's rules 47 C.F. R. § 1.62.
6. This action is issued pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. §0.261, and is effective immediately.

## **STA Extension Request**

**Hawaii Pacific Teleport (HPT) requests an extension of the special temporary authority (“STA”) to operate a Ka-band earth station to provide in-orbit testing (“IOT”) services for a BIU mission. Pursuant to the authority in File Number SES-STA-20160323-00268, HPT is providing IOT of the Nimiq-2 at 148° E.L. orbital location in the 29.5 – 30.0 GHz (Earth-to-space) frequency band. The testing involves 30-45 minute spectrum plots either once per day or once per week.**
