Intelsat License LLC. (Intelsat) is granted special temporary authority for 30 days, beginning June 13, 2016, to operate its fixed earth station in Napa, California to provide communications services for the Intelsat 8 (S2460) satellite at 168.9 E.L. in the 14.0-14.5 GHz (Earth-to-space) frequency band on the following conditions:

1. In the event of any harmful interference as a result of operations under this grant of STA, Intelsat shall cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference and shall immediately inform the Commission, in writing, of such an event.
3. All operations shall be on an unprotected, non-interference basis to both government and non-government operations.
4. Operation from expiration of authority granted under SES-STA-20160405-00318 was authorized pursuant to Section 1.62 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. §1.62.
5. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this STA is solely at Intelsat's own risk.
5. Grant of this authorization is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding any pending or future Intelsat applications.

This action is issued pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. §0.261, and is effective immediately.
