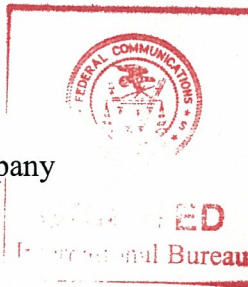

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Independence Television Company is granted STA, beginning July 26, 2016, for 30 days to operate its earth station E160133 at Louisville, KY at 38° 15' 5.2" NL/85° 45' 43.8"W.L. with AMC-9 at 83° W.L. orbital location and SES-2 at 87° W.L. orbital location to provide video uplink for transmitting news and event coverage with frequency band 14.0 – 14.5 GHz (Earth-to-space) and 11.8971 – 12.189 GHz (space-to-Earth) within the coordinated emission and power limits under the following conditions:

1. Grant of this STA is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding pending or future Independence Television Company LLC applications.
2. All operations under this grant of STA shall be on an unprotected and non-harmful interference basis. Independence Television Company shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from interference caused to it by, any other lawfully operating radio communication system.
3. In the event of any harmful interference as a result of operations under this grant of STA, Independence Television Company shall cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference and shall immediately inform the Commission, in writing, of such an event.
4. Transmitters(s) must be turned off during antenna maintenance to ensure compliance with the FCC-specified safety guidelines for human exposure to radiofrequency radiation in the region between the antenna feed and the reflector. Appropriate measures must also be taken to restrict access to other regions in which the earth station's power flux density levels exceed the specified guidelines.
5. The licensee shall take all necessary measures to ensure that the antenna does not create potential exposure of humans to radiofrequency radiation in excess of the FCC exposure limits defined in 47 CFR 1.1307(b) and 1.1310 wherever such exposures might occur. Measures must be taken to ensure compliance with limits for both occupational/controlled exposure and for general population/uncontrolled exposure, as defined in these rule sections. The FCC's OET Bulletin 65 (available on-line at www.fcc.gov/oet/rfsafety) provides information on predicting exposure levels and on methods for ensuring compliance, including the use of warning and alerting signs and protective equipment for workers.
6. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this STA is solely at Independence Television Company's risk.

This grant is issued pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. § 0.261, and is effective upon release.

The applicant now requests STA to operate the earth station beginning on **July 14, 2016**, according to the technical parameters proposed by the pending application, and until the permanent license application is granted. The earth station will be used in connection with the broadcast operations of WDRB(TV), Louisville, Kentucky. The public interest would be well served by grant of STA to allow for use of the new station until the permanent authorization is issued.


