Special Temporary Authority

Intelsat License, LLC, is granted a special temporary authority, extension from SES-STA-20161221-00967, for 30 days, beginning February 17, 2017, to operate its 1.2 meter Ku-band antenna located in Hagerstown, Maryland, to communicate with Intelsat 29e (S2913) at 50° W.L. in order to test customer's equipment, using the following frequency bands: 10.95-12.50 GHz (space-to-Earth) and 14.00-14.50 GHz (Earth-to-space) under the following conditions:

1. All operations under this grant of special temporary authority are on an unprotected and non-harmful interference basis. Intelsat License, LLC, must not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from interference caused to it by, any other lawfully operating station.
2. In the event of any harmful interference under this grant of special temporary authority, Intelsat License, LLC, must cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference, and must inform the Commission, in writing, immediately of such an event.
3. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this special temporary authority is solely 'at Intelsat License, LLC's risk.
4. Operations are restricted to parameters defined in SAT-LOA-20130722-00097.
5. The licensee shall take extraordinary measures to ensure that the antenna does not create the potential for radiation exposure to persons who may be within the immediate vicinity. Radiofrequency radiation may not exceed the FCC safety guideline of 1 mW/cm². Warning signs, such as those discussed in the FCC's OET Bulletin 65, shall be posted informing members of the public to keep outside the exposure area that exceeds limit.
6. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this special temporary authority is solely at Intelsat License, LLC's risk.
7. This authorization is issued pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. § 0.261, and is effective immediately.

Intelsat License LLC (“Intelsat”) herein requests an additional 30 days of Special Temporary Authority (“STA”)¹ previously granted Intelsat to utilize a 1.2m Ku-band antenna located at its Hagerstown, Maryland teleport to provide communications with Intelsat 29e (S2913) in order to test customer equipment.² Intelsat expects to file an application to permanent license this antenna.

Intelsat will continue performing operations in the following frequency bands: 10.95 – 12.75 GHz and 14.00 – 14.50 GHz.

In further support of this extension request, Intelsat incorporates by reference Exhibit A, a radiation hazard analysis report, submitted with its original STA request.

Grant of this STA extension request will allow Intelsat to successfully complete testing of customer equipment. This, in turn, will help provide customer service and thereby promote the public interest.
