Intelsat License LLC (“Intelsat”) herein supplements its above referenced request for Special Temporary Authority (“STA”). Specifically, Intelsat is updating the record to reflect a new commencement and new launch date. Accordingly, the first paragraph should now read:

Intelsat License LLC (“Intelsat”) herein requests a grant of Special Temporary Authority (“STA”) for 30 days, commencing **April 15, 2017**, to utilize a 9.2m Ka-band antenna located at its Riverside, California teleport to provide launch and early orbit phase (“LEOP”) services for the EchoStar-21 satellite. EchoStar-21 is expected to be launched **no earlier than April 15, 2017**. The LEOP period is expected to last approximately 10 days.
