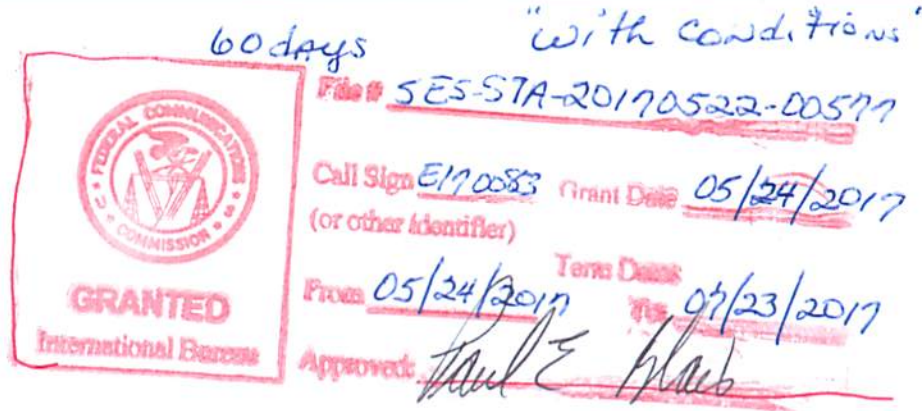

Special Temporary Authority

Intelsat License LLC is granted a special temporary authority for 60 days, beginning on May 24, 2017, to operate its 2.4 meter Ku-band antenna located in Hagerstown, Maryland to communicate with Intelsat 29e satellite (S2913) at 50° W.L. in order to test customer's equipment, using the following frequency bands: 10.95 - 12.50 GHz (space-to-Earth) and 14.00 - 14.50 GHz (Earth-to-space) under the following conditions:

1. Operations, shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from, interference caused to it by any other lawfully operating station and it shall cease transmission(s) immediately upon notice of such interference.
2. In the event of any harmful interference under this grant of special temporary authority, Intelsat License LLC, must cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference, and must inform the Commission, in writing, immediately of such an event.

4. Grant of this authorization is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding pending application SES-LIC-20170315-00271.
5. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this special temporary authority is solely at Intelsat License LLC's risk.
6. Grant of this authorization is with prejudice to any future enforcement actions.
7. This action is issued pursuant to Section 0261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. §0.261, and is effective immediately.

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Intelsat License LLC ("Intelsat") herein requests an additional 60 days of Special Temporary Authority ("STA")¹ previously granted Intelsat to utilize a 2.4m Ku-band antenna located at its Hagerstown, Maryland teleport to provide communications with Intelsat 29e (S2913) in order to test customer equipment.² Intelsat has filed an application to permanent license this antenna.³

Intelsat will continue performing operations in the following frequency bands: 10.70 – 12.75 GHz and 14.00 – 14.50 GHz.

In further support of this extension request, Intelsat incorporates by reference Exhibit A, a radiation hazard analysis report, submitted with its original STA request.

Grant of this STA extension request will allow Intelsat to successfully complete testing of customer equipment. This, in turn, will help provide customer service and thereby promote the public interest.


