Special Temporary Authority

Intelsat License LLC is granted a special temporary authority for 30 days, under the following conditions, beginning August 28, 2017, to operate its C-band earth station, call sign E4132, in Fillmore, California, to provide launch and early orbit phase (LEOP) services for the Indian Regional Navigational Satellite System (IRNSS-1H) satellite at 55° E.L. licensed by India, using the following frequencies: 6415 MHz and 6421.48 MHz (RHCP) (Earth-to-space) and 4194 MHz, and 4199.28 MHz (LHCP) (space-to-Earth). IRNSS-1H satellite expected to launched on August 28, 2017.

1. All operations must be within the coordinated emission and power limits.
2. The LEOP operations must be coordinated with all operators of satellites that use the same frequency bands and are in the LEOP path. All operators of satellites in that path will be provided with an emergency phone number where the licensee can be reached in the event that harmful interference occurs. Currently the 24x7 contact information for the IRNSS-1H satellite LEOP mission is as follows: Ph.: (703) 559-7701 -East Coast Operations Center (primary); (310) 525-5591- West Coast Operations Center (back-up). 3. All operations shall be on an unprotected and non-harmful interference basis, Intelsat License LLC, E4132, shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from interference caused to it by any other lawfully operating station and it shall cease transmission(s) immediately upon notice of such interference.
4. Grant of this authorization is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding pending or future Intelsat License LLC applications.
5. This special temporary authority can only be used to provide launch and early orbit phase ("LEOP") services for the IRNSS-1H satellite.
6. This action is issued pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. §0.261, and is effective immediately.

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Intelsat License LLC ("Intelsat") herein requests a grant of Special Temporary Authority ("STA")¹ for 30 days, commencing August 28, 2017, to use its Fillmore, California C-band earth station—call sign E4132—to provide launch and early orbit phase ("LEOP") services for the Indian Regional Navigational Satellite System ("IRNSS") 1H satellite. IRNSS-1H is expected to be launched on August 28, 2017.² The LEOP period is expected to last approximately 10 days.³

The IRNSS-1H LEOP operations will be performed at the following frequencies: 6415.00 MHz and 6421.48 MHz in the uplink (RHCP), and 4194.0 MHz and 4199.28 MHz in the downlink (LHCP). The LEOP operations will be coordinated with all operators of satellites that use the same frequency bands and are in the LEOP path.⁴ All operators of satellites in that path will be provided with an emergency phone number where the licensee can be reached in the event that harmful interference occurs.

In further support of this request, Intelsat herewith attaches Exhibits A and B, which contains technical information that demonstrates that the operation of the earth station will be compatible with its

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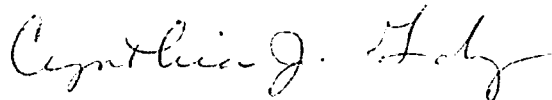
electromagnetic environment and will not cause harmful interference into any lawfully operating terrestrial facility and a waiver request. In the extremely unlikely event that harmful interference should occur due to transmissions to or from its earth station, Intelsat will take all reasonable steps to eliminate the interference.

Finally, Intelsat clarifies that during the IRNSS-1H launch, the Indian Space Research Organisation ("ISRO") will control the spacecraft. ISRO will build and send the commands to the Intelsat antenna, which will process and execute the commands. Telemetry received by Intelsat will be forwarded to ISRO. Intelsat will remain in control of the baseband unit, RF equipment, and antenna.

Grant of this STA request will allow Intelsat to help launch the IRNSS-1H satellite. This, in turn, will help provide navigation services to India and neighboring areas from the 55.0° E.L. orbital location and thereby promotes the public interest.
