Special Temporary Authority

Intelsat License, LLC is granted a special temporary authority extension from SES-STA-20170613-00645, for 30 days, beginning August 16, 2017, to operate its C-band earth station antenna (call sign: E000296) located in Hagerstown, Maryland, to provide in-orbit testing ("IOT") of the Intelsat 35e satellite (S2959) at 33° W.L., orbital location in the 5925-5929 MHz, 6080-6107 MHz, 6169-6181 MHz, 6199-6210 MHz, 6258-6299 MHz, 6332-6359 MHz, and 6392-6425 MHz (Earth-to-space) frequency bands, under the following conditions:

- 2. All operations under this grant of special temporary authority shall be on an unprotected and non-harmful interference basis. Intelsat License, LLC's shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from interference caused to it by, any other lawfully operating radio communication system.
- 3. In the event of any harmful interference as a result of operations under this grant of special temporary authority, Intelsat License, LLC, shall cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference and shall immediately inform the Commission, in writing, of such an event.
- 4. Grant of this authorization is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding pending or future Intelsat License, LLC's applications.
- 5. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this special temporary authority is solely at Intelsat License, LLC's risk.

6. This action is issued pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. §0.261, and is effective immediately.

Intelsat License LLC ("Intelsat") herein requests an additional 30 days of Special Temporary Authority ("STA") previously granted Intelsat to use its Hagerstown, Maryland C-band earth station—call sign E000296—to provide in-orbit testing ("IOT") services<sup>2</sup> to Intelsat 35e at 33.0° W.L.<sup>3</sup> Intelsat 35e was launched on July 5, 2017. The IOT is expected to last approximately 45 days.

The Intelsat 35e operations will continue to be performed using the following frequencies: 5925-5929 MHz, 6080-6107 MHz, 6169-6181 MHz, 6199-6210 MHz, 6258-6299 MHz, 6332-6359 MHz, and 6392-6425 MHz. The Intelsat 35e operations will continue to be coordinated with all operators of satellites that are potentially affected by these operations at the IOT location. All operators of potentially affected satellites will be provided with an emergency phone number where the licensee can be reached in the event that harmful interference occurs.

In the extremely unlikely event that harmful interference should occur due to transmissions to or from its earth station, intelesat will take all reasonable steps to climinate the interference.

Grant of this STA extension request will allow inteleat to continue in-orbit testing of the Inteleat 35e satellite. This, in turn, will help provide additional capacity to customers at the 34.5° W.L. orbital location and thereby promotes the public interest.
